# Cross-Disciplinary Approaches to Advancing Sustainable Arctic Infrastructure

SATURDAY 26 MARCH 2022 / 14:00 - 18:00 CEST (GMT+1)

The 2022 RATIC/T-MOSAiC community meeting in Tromsø provides an opportunity to explore crossdisciplinary approaches to understanding the impacts of infrastructure and climate change in the Arctic. This half-day hybrid meeting focuses on topics prioritized at past RATIC events: 1) Approaches and recent progress in Arctic infrastructure mapping, modeling and monitoring; 2) Arctic community perspectives on infrastructure research and policy needs; and 3) Updates from national and international research initiatives addressing Arctic change, resilience and adaptation in natural, built and social systems. The meeting is supported by funding for cross-cutting activities from the IASC Terrestrial and Social & Human Working Groups.
